

Do you have Medicare?

If single:

Is your monthly income \$1,679 or less?*

If married:

Is your monthly income \$2,259 or less?*

(Income can be up to \$2,571 if only one spouse signs up for the Medicare Savings Program.)*

*** If you are working, income can be even higher!**

**If your answers are YES, you are eligible for Maine's
Medicare Savings Program (MSP).
Eligibility has expanded!**

(The Medicare Savings Program is also known as Medicare Buy-In.)

When you sign up for the Medicare Savings Program:

- ✓ **Your Medicare Part B premium (\$96.40 per month) will be paid**
- ✓ **Your ONLY Medicare Part D (drug) expense will be a maximum of \$2.80 for brand name drugs covered by your prescription drug plan. There is no cost for generic drugs!**

Be sure to show the pharmacist your Low Cost Drugs for the Elderly and Disabled (DEL) card to get the lowest costs. When you sign up for the Medicare Savings Program, you also get the Low Cost Drugs for the Elderly and Disabled (DEL) benefit.

Some people will have almost ALL Medicare costs paid for!

If your monthly income is \$1,375 or less (\$1,850 for a married couple—or up to \$2,162 if only one spouse enrolls in the Medicare Savings Program), your ONLY Medicare costs (for Parts A, B, and D) will be a \$1.55 or \$2.80 copay for brand name drugs!
